That the Puerto Rico Council on Education, at its regular meeting held on August 25, 2016, pursuant to the authority conferred by the Reorganization Plan Number 1, of July 26, 2010, as amended, approved the Renewal License of **Universidad Ana G. Méndez** to continue operating as a higher education institution in Puerto Rico. This license is valid for a five (5) years term (from August 25, 2016 to August 24, 2021) and is granted on the basis of the academic offerings through distance education mode mentioned below and the places where these are offered.



The Council also determined to require the institution to submit two Compliance Reports to meet the criteria of financial capacity. The first report shall present the Strategic Development Plan (2016-2020 Strategic Guidelines) duly approved by the Board of Directors of the Ana G. Méndez University System. This report shall be submitted in November 2016. The second report must include a document certified by Ana G. Mendez University which reports the annual contribution of Ana G. Méndez University System to the income of the institution. This report should be submitted by or before August 31 of each year, certifying the contribution of the previous year, until the institution can prove its financial independence of the contribution of the Ana G. Méndez University System.

This certification is issued under Chapter III of the Regulation for the Licensing of Institutions of Higher Education in Puerto Rico, No. 8265 (2012). The institution continues to be obliged to comply with the responsibilities of holding the license. The PRCE retains its authority to verify compliance with such responsibilities in any instance during the course of the term of the license.
